Jeanette Lavalais reported that after school snacks are being offered to students staying for tutorials. They fall in the guidelines provided.

Quinn Godwin and Janell Vickrey reported on the TxDOT grant for Project Graduation. Mothers Against Drunk Drivers will have a presentation 2-13-14. The Texas Department of Public Safety will have a presentation on February 26, 2014 for the Junior and Senior classes. "When Sean Speaks" is a \$2500 program to be held on April 16, 2014. TxDOT will pay for the presentation.
